

Causes

Too much food Not Enough Insulin Decreased activity Illness Infection Stress

Symptoms

Thirst Fatigue Nausea

Frequent urination Blurred vision

Action Necessary

Check blood glucose Check urine for ketones Glucose > 300 mg/dL or level set in Diabetes Care Plan



Mild

(Negative or trace/small ketones)

- Provide water or sugar-free beverage
- Allow unrestricted access to restroom
- Recheck blood glucose and ketones if symptoms persist
- For pumpers, follow protocol



Moderate/Severe

(Ketones = moderate to large)

- Provide sugar-free beverages 16-24 oz over 2 hours
- Allow unrestricted access to restroom
- Observe for signs of fruity smelling breath
- Administer insulin per Diabetes Care Plan
- Recheck blood glucose & ketones
- For pumpers, change set per protocol
- Call parent if child continues to have the above symptoms, vomits, is lethargic or is too ill to remain in school
- Call provider if parent unavailable
